#### **Religious Education**

#### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION MODULE: STAGE 2, YEAR 3: 'LIVING THE GOOD NEWS OF THE GOSPEL'

This module will introduce students to the gospels as a unique form of literature, which for Christians is "Good News" as illustrated in Mark's gospel which begins with the words, "This is the Good News about Jesus Christ, the Son of God" (Mk1:1). Students will begin to explore the four gospels of the canon of the New Testament, the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. They will be introduced the idea that these gospels are not biographies of Jesus' life despite containing biographical details. "They are complex testaments of faith based on the life and ministry of Jesus of Nazareth" (Ryan, M Teaching the Bible 2001, Nelson Cengage Learning, Melbourne, p. 84)

Students will learn that the gospels are built out of the faith of New Testament communities who had a strong belief in Jesus' resurrection. They will learn that each of the gospels which arose out of oral tradition were compiled to address particular circumstances in the communities of each gospel writer. Whilst written for communities two thousand years ago, they still have meaning for us today. We are able to reflect upon all four gospels to explore the life and teachings of Jesus and to consider how the work of the gospel writers in telling Jesus' story may help us to live the Good News in the 21st century.


